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Front cover: A Russian canteen was unearthed at a German prisoner-of-war (POW) camp in Czersk, Poland. It is, however, unique in that a POW has engraved it with beautiful artwork depicting an idealised couple (perhaps the PoW and his partner) embracing. Thus, the artefact represents a material memory of love: behind the carvings stand emotions, thoughts, actions and individuals that existed during the First World War.

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
