J. R. BUSVINE

Professor Busvine's research into the control of medically important arthropods (especially lice, fleas, bed bugs and itch mites) has yielded him a rich store of curious information, part scientific, part literary-historical. His introductory account of the evolutionary histories of insects and mites leads on to a fascinating study of human reactions to ectoparasites, showing how the extent of man's curiosity about them and references to their prevalence provide a continuous commentary both on the history of biological science from Aristotle to the present day and on the modes and manners of past ages.


