THE AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Council and Members of the Fauna Preservation Society.

ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST DECEMBER, 1962

We have completed the audit of the Books and Accounts of the Society for the year ended 31st December, 1962, and report thereon as follows:—

GENERAL PURPOSES ACCOUNT

The Balance on this Account at the end of the year was £856 5s. 8d. after transferring £35 from the Life Membership Fund, and deducting £9 14s. 9d. loss on Sale of Investments, and £1,444 16s. 2d., being the excess of Expenditure over Income on the year's working.

The excess of Expenditure over Income in the previous year was

£1,440 15s. 5d.

GENERAL RESERVE FUND

The Balance on this Fund at the 1st January, 1962, was £7,240 1s. 1d., to which has been added £920 0s. 2d. in respect of Donations and Legacy transferred from Income and Expenditure Account.

A transfer of £853 4s. 1d. has been made from this Fund to meet Expenditure on the "Operation Oryx" Fund, leaving a Balance at

31st December, 1962, of £7,306 17s. 2d.

NUMBER OF MEMBERS ON THE ROLL

The number of Members on the Roll at 31st December, 1962, was 2,307, made up as follows:—

This shows an increase of 1 Honorary Member, 27 Life Members and 147 Ordinary Members.

LIFE MEMBERSHIP FUND

The balance standing to the credit of the Fund is now £6,170. This is after crediting £370 in respect of Life Membership Subscriptions received during the year and transferring £35 to the General Purposes Account which represents the value of subscriptions of those Life Members whose membership ceased during the year.

INVESTMENTS

The total investments at 31st December, 1962, at Cost amounted to £15,147 3s. 11d., and the Market Value at that date was £16,341 14s. 11d., showing a net appreciation of £1,194 11s. The transaction effected during the year resulted in a loss of £9 14s. 9d.

SURPLUS

The surplus of Assets over Liabilities at the end of the year amounted to £14,333 2s. 10d., as compared with £15,350 17s. 8d. at the end of the previous year.

"OPERATION NOAH"

Kariba Fund

Donations of £13 2s. 10d. were received during the year and after administration charges of £5 5s., the Balance on the Fund at 31st December, 1962, was £395 3s. 10d.

"OPERATION ORYX"

We have examined the transactions relating to this Fund and annexed is the Receipts and Payments Account from the commencement of the Fund in July, 1961.

Donations have been received to date amounting to £3,797 5s. and expenditure incurred of £4,625 11s. 1d. Of this expenditure, £853 4s. 1d. has been paid from the Society's General Account and a transfer of this amount has been made from the General Reserve Fund. This transfer may be subject to adjustment if further donations are received.
