## MRCPsych Part I Examination – Autumn 1998

The following 235 candidates were successful in the MRCPsych Part I Examination held in Autumn 1998, from a total of 500 candidates who sat the Examination (pass rate: 47%).

In accordance with the Examination Regulations, these candidates may now proceed to the MRCPsych Part II Examination, provided that they satisfy the requirements for entry: two-and-a-half years (30 months) full-time post-registration approved training, a minimum of two years' registration as a medical practitioner in the United Kingdom or Republic of Ireland and sponsorship by their tutor and consultant who are subscribing Members or Fellows of the College.
