And just as no court is ever an infallible arbiter of legal obligation—the individual may sometimes have to stand by his or her own conscientious reading of the law—Parliament cannot be accorded unqualified authority to *change* the law. The interpretation and application of statutes must always be a matter of judicial deliberation and judgement, just as the application of government policies and administrative orders is ultimately subject to the requirements of justice in particular cases.
