## JOINT ANNOUNCEMENT

by the Boards of Editors of the Netherlands International Law Review (Nederlands Tijdschrift voor Internationaal Recht) and of the Netherlands Yearbook of International Law.

The publication of an inter-university Netherlands Yearbook of International Law under the auspices of the T.M.C. Asser Institute at The Hague, and the arrangements made for an effective contribution by the said Institute to the Netherlands International Law Review, have led to the logical need for more co-ordination between the Yearbook and the Review. This has resulted in an agreement, under which there will be a single subscription for both Review and Yearbook. While henceforth only three issues, totalling about 400 pages, of the Review will appear annually, the Yearbook will include a maximum of another three to four hundred pages. The combined subscription rate, as from 1971, will be Dfl. 66,-. The price of separate copies of the Yearbook is Dfl. 40,- while separate issues of the Review will be available at Dfl. 17,- each.

As for the year 1970, it has been decided that the first volume of the Yearbook will be offered to the subscribers to the *Review*, taking the place of the latter's fourth issue, by way of introduction.

We sincerely hope that this arrangement, which aims at the greatest possible spread of the Dutch contribution in the field of international law, will be satisfactory to the needs and wishes of our readers.
