The leafhoppers and planthoppers (Auchenorrhyncha) have become increasingly important in recent years both as vectors of plant diseases and because of the direct damage they cause to crops, including rice, the staple diet of a large proportion of the world's human population.

Progress in their control has been hindered by problems of taxonomy, classification and biology, and in October 1982 an international workshop was held in London to study these problems. The proceedings are now available and contain about 40 papers presented by contributors from countries worldwide.
