

# Using population surveys and models to reassess the conservation status of an endemic Amazonian titi monkey in a deforestation hotspot—CORRIGENDUM

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In the original publication of this article, there was a mistake in the abstract. The following sentence was incorrect: ‘Habitat loss was estimated to be 58,365 km<sup>2</sup> (32.3% of its current range) over the next 24 years (three *P. bernhardi* generations) under a conservative governance model of deforestation and 105,289 km<sup>2</sup> (58.3%) under a business-as-usual model.’

The correct sentence is: ‘Habitat loss was estimated to be 58,365 km<sup>2</sup> (44.5% of its current range) over the next 24 years (three *P. bernhardi* generations) under a conservative

governance model of deforestation and 105,289 km<sup>2</sup> (80.2%) under a business-as-usual model.’

The article has been updated with the correct sentence.
