... (i) climbing, playing with a ball and playing tag were rated as 0 (=rarely) if reported as less than 3–6 times per week, otherwise as 1 (=frequently); (ii) cycling was rated as 0 (=rarely) if reported as less than every day, otherwise as 1 (=frequently) ...
