Each issue (128 pages) contains eight to ten articles which reveal the wealth and beauty of the spiritual teachings of the theology of St Thomas Aquinas, the official theologian of the Church.

A survey of the indexes of Cross and Crown reveals its varied scope in subject matter and contributors. Eminent authorities in spiritual theology have explained in plain, striking phrases what the life of God in man really is.
