

DOCTORAL DISSERTATIONS ON RUSSIA, THE SOVIET UNION, AND EASTERN EUROPE ACCEPTED BY AMERICAN, CANADIAN, AND BRITISH UNIVERSITIES, 1970-1971

This year's listing of doctoral research on Russia and the Soviet Union is one of the largest, with two hundred forty-five titles. Thirty-five of these can be added to the past established 1969 total, and one hundred twenty-three titles can be added to the 1970 total. Eighty-six dissertations accepted in 1971 (plus one old one missed in 1966) round out the current list. Because degrees are also granted by most universities past the usual June commencement, with some awarded as late as December, complete coverage in current listings is not possible at this time. In addition, as has been explained in previous introductions, the delayed responses of a handful of graduate schools, the practice of a few universities of refusing to compile doctoral lists, the very late appearance of *American Doctoral Dissertations* by as much as two years, and a publication deadline prevent the 1971 listing from being complete.

Of the sixty-five (sixty-two American and three Canadian) universities represented in this list, Columbia University, the University of Washington, New York University, the University of California at Los Angeles and at Berkeley, Indiana University, Harvard University, and the University of Wisconsin are the major contributors.

The listing for Eastern Europe, produced by fifty-five American and four Canadian universities, is also unusually large, with one hundred thirty-seven titles, compared with sixty-nine for last year. The separate British list includes twenty-eight dissertations, nineteen of which are concerned with Russia and the Soviet Union. The University of London continues to be the major producer.

Thirty-one supplementary items referred to as "auxiliary theses" have been appended to several sections. These dissertations are not concerned primarily with Russia, the Soviet Union, or Eastern Europe, but they do contain enough relevant information of interest and value—in various chapters or sections—to warrant their inclusion.

In the listing as a whole, the bulk of the research is again to be found in history, political science, economics, literature, and language.
