A General Assembly of the International Astronomical Union is held every three years. The majority of active astronomers from all over the world convene and report about their activity and plans for the future. The present volume entitled "Proceedings of the XIVth General Assembly, Brighton, 1970", appearing in the series "Transactions of the International Astronomical Union", contains the complete record of the Inaugural Ceremony and of the two sessions of the General Assembly, as well as the texts of resolutions adopted by the Assembly.

180 Meeting reports of 48 Commissions, covering all branches and methods of astronomy, give the basis for cooperation and organized activity in the near future.

Part IV of the book deals with the new Statutes and By-laws of the International Astronomical Union, the working rules adopted by the Executive Committee, and the rules for organizing scientific meetings.

At the end of the volume appear the Membership of Commissions and the Alphabetical List of Members of the International Astronomical Union.
