Pre-meeting workshops, April 17, include Update on Antimicrobial Resistance, Emerging Nosocomial Fungi, DNA Typing Techniques in Infection Control,

Plenary sessions during the meeting will address emerging infectious hazards, environmental infectious hazards, and biomaterial-related infections. Concurrent symposia include pediatric infection control hot issues or cutting-edge changes in the OR; and medical-device quality issues or handwashing controversies.

Abstract submission deadline is January 8, 1999; hotel reservation deadline is March 19; and advance registration deadline is April 2.
