This volume provides a comprehensive historical and critical analysis of the minnesong and of the period in which it flourished in Germany and Austria — between the twelfth and fifteenth centuries. The authors present the first large, representative anthology of minnesongs, including music, German lyrics, and English verse translations. They provide illustrations from the original manuscripts and a 33½ rpm recording of songs of the principal minnesingers with instruments of the period accompanying the vocalists.
