I am the author of several books about Katyn and have made an intensive study of the subject. My information is that overall responsibility could be ascribed to NKVD Generals Raichmann and Saburin. Under them the massacre at Katyn itself was directed by Comrade Burianov while Colonel Kutschov was in charge of the shooting of the prisoners from Starobielsk camp at Dergachi. A final report on the whole operation is said to have been signed by a certain Tartakov who was organizational head of the NKVD office at Minsk.
