OSHA's Proposed TB Standard

Michael L. Tapper, MD, chairman of the AIDS/TB Committee, responded to the reopening of the docket for OSHA's proposed TB standard. This has been an area of considerable controversy in the United States and an area of great concern to many SHEA members, especially because recent science and the significant achievements to control the transmission of TB in the workplace did not influence OSHA's proposed TB standard. Referring to SHEA's conclusions of February 1998, Dr. Tapper stated that "... the criterion for determining that existing conditions pose a significant risk to healthcare workers has not been met and that the promulgation of the proposed standard cannot be scientifically justified at this time."
