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The Compositae is a large family which contains a number of economically important plants and from which many valuable plant products have been obtained. However no overall resumé has been attempted until now because of its complexity. The contributors to this book, all of whom have carried out significant research on the group in recent years, have presented their findings in a form which provides the first fully comprehensive survey of both the systematics and comparative biochemistry of the Compositae, which is complete at the generic level. Not only is each tribe given detailed individual consideration, but in addition there is a unique collection of general reviews on the biology and chemistry of the Family as a whole.

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
