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THE HARPER UNIT ST ANDREW'S HOSPITAL, NORTHAMPTON

Opened in January 1991, the Harper Unit has been developed as an assessment unit for elderly patients with mental disorders.

This new self-contained unit specialises in providing full medical, psychiatric, functional and cognitive assessments of elderly patients.

Each assessment is carried out by a multi-disciplinary team which provides a detailed diagnostic report with recommendations for a future care and treatment plan.

The unit has accommodation for up to six in-patients, and the full assessment programme may take between four to six weeks. Each patient is accommodated in a private bedroom with full use of all the hospital's facilities.
