The data shown represent non diet carbonated and soft drinks only. The footnote should have read:

NDNS group: non diet concentrated, carbonated and ready to drink soft drinks (including water as a dilutent); NI group: non diet concentrated, carbonated and ready to drink soft drinks (including water as a dilutent and/or water as a drink).
