FULL PROFESSOR IN AIRCRAFT STRUCTURES

with emphasis on the layout and design aspects of aerospace structures. A scientific staff, formerly under the supervision of the late Professor Van Beek, is engaged in this field of activities.

Practical design experience at a supervisory level, a good scientific background and familiarity with modern analytical and numerical methods related to the design of aircraft and spacecraft structures are essential.

The applicant will be responsible for lectures dealing with air-load calculations, applied structural analysis and design. He will also supervise the thesis work of students specialising in structural design during the last two years before graduation. In addition it is desirable that he be able to provide leadership by the introduction of one or more of the following activities: computer aided design, structural optimisation and design with composite materials.

A structural laboratory is available for research by staff and students; also the university computing centre is at the disposal of the department.

The salary depends on age and experience, with a limit amounting to Dfl. 134.000, per annum.
