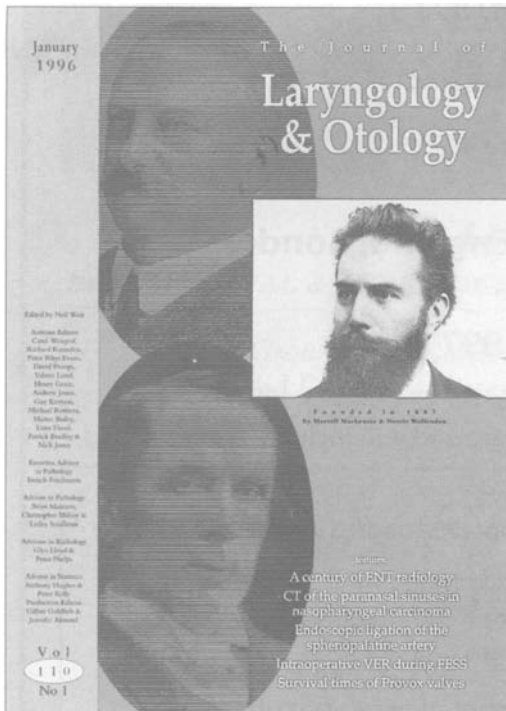

RHINOPLASTY UPDATE

November 24th, 25th and 26th

Course Objectives

The course is designed to provide a comprehensive review for those experienced in rhinoplasty with a third practical day of supervised anatomical dissection on soft-fix cadavers.

Course Structure

Each of the sessions for the first two days will have a main topic theme presented by the moderator. Three subsequent short topics will then be discussed by other faculty members supported with slide and video presentations. There will be ample time for discussion on each topic and participants are encouraged to bring along photographs of problem cases.

The third day is based at the Royal College of Surgeons using the excellent dissection facilities of the Raven Education Department. After a brief lecture, participants will undertake supervised structured nasal dissection which includes the principles of grafting and suture techniques related to rhinoplasty.

Topics to be covered

Basic techniques – management of the upper lateral cartilages, approaches to the alar cartilages, infraction techniques

Pre-operative assessment – the patient not to take on, ethnic considerations, photography

The deviated nose – osteotomies, the septum, camouflage

Tricks with the septum – caudal displacement/shortening of the nose, spreader grafts/valve surgery, suture techniques

The difficult tip – underprojection, overprojection, asymmetry

Saddle and grafts – saddle deformation, tip grafts, composite grafts

External approach – tip augmentation options, incision planning, flap and scar problems, technique limitations

Revision rhinoplasty and the disillusioned patient – technical problems associated with revision surgery, medico-legal aspects, patient satisfaction
