
*Doctoral Dissertations
on Russia, the Soviet Union, and Eastern
Europe Accepted by American,
Canadian, and British Universities, 1974–1975*

It seems safe to state at this point that 1972 was the peak year for output in doctoral research on Russia and the Soviet Union. The figures for 1973 and 1974 show a very slight decline which may indicate that a plateau has been reached. Whether this situation is a temporary one, or a long-term trend, will be revealed only over the next few years. The output for the seventies, however, still is considerably higher than the sixties. Of the two hundred sixty-one titles in the current list, four are from earlier years previously undetected, one from 1971, six from 1972, nineteen from 1973, one hundred fifty-eight from 1974, and seventy-three from 1975. The slightly smaller number for 1975 is attributable to the fact that a larger than usual number of universities have delayed in forwarding their lists. Because degrees are also granted by most universities past the usual spring commencement, with some awarded as late as December, complete coverage for the calendar year in current listings is not possible at this time. In addition, the practice of a few universities of refusing to compile doctoral lists, the very late appearance of *American Doctoral Dissertations* (by as much as two years), and a publication deadline prevent this 1975 listing from being complete. Eighty universities are represented (seventy-four in the United States and six in Canada).

The listing for Eastern Europe contains ninety-four dissertations from forty American and four Canadian universities. The separate British list contains twenty-nine titles representing the output of ten universities. Unfortunately, the list from Oxford University was not available.

Twenty-eight supplementary items, "auxiliary theses," have been appended to several sections.

For a list of dissertations accepted through 1959 see the author's *Doctoral Research on Russia and the Soviet Union* (New York, 1960). An accompanying volume 2, *Doctoral Research on Russia and the Soviet Union, 1960–1975* (New York: Garland Publishing Inc., 1976), has just been published. Volume 2 contains not only the more than three thousand titles which have appeared in the listings that have been published annually in the December issue of *Slavic Review* since 1964 (the 1964 listing also included dissertations accepted in 1960–63), but also items not previously listed in volume 1. In addition, volume 2 offers some critical and statistical analysis, over thirty major classifications, numerous sub- and sub-subclassifications, cross references, an index of Russian and Soviet names, and an index of authors.
