but this was not with him a reason for indulging in the *dolce far niente*, as he threw himself into the study of marine zoology. Eventually he found an outlet for his energy in fruit-growing, and he studied it enthusiastically in Canada, where he ended his days.

One of his many-sided interests was a love of music, an art in which he excelled. He showed himself a skilful conductor when he organised an orchestra in the London Hospital. A late physician to that institution expressed the opinion that he was a good man "in spite of his being a musician." He translated and annotated Joal's work on *Respiration in Singing*.

His force of character showed itself in his writings and his oral communications, and as a confidential associate of Sir Morell Mackenzie in the care of the German Crown Prince, when, in this country, Wolfenden bore himself manfully in the controversial discussions in which he was involved. A certain amount of pride with a touch of arrogance gave him an air of distinction which was not unbecoming; his impatience at contradiction associated with a tendency to express a difference of opinion, made things sometimes a little difficult for his colleagues. His quiet qualities, however, far outweighed this little defect, and anyone who dips into the earlier volumes of the *Journal* will realise that he was a strong man, and that he took a most important part in the advancement of the knowledge of scientific laryngology among English-speaking people.

### THE JUBILEE OF PROFESSOR SCHMIEGELOW.

On the 13th October, Dr E. Schmiegelow, Professor of Oto-laryngology in the University of Copenhagen, celebrated his 70th birthday by delivering his last lecture at the Rigshospital before finishing his active career as



Chief of the Clinic and as Professor. That he is not without honour in his own country was shown by the manifestations of esteem and regard from his townsmen and compatriots, who presented him with a striking portrait of himself, painted by the well-known Danish artist, Henningesen. In addition, the brotherhood of laryngologists in other lands united to present him with a bas-relief portrait in bronze, by the Swedish artist, Costa Carrell. This has been subscribed to by friends and admirers from many countries, under the leadership of Gunnar Holmgren (Stockholm) who, in their name, presented it to the Throat Clinic of the Rigshospital.

Amongst the representatives who supported him were numerous colleagues from Sweden and Norway and, amongst other, Burger (Amsterdam), Marschik (Vienna), Spiess (Frankfurt), von Eicken, Kuttner, and Flatau (Berlin), and Sir St Clair Thomson (London).

The Jubilee was further celebrated by a meeting of the Danish Oto-laryngological Society, presided over by Dr Strandberg. The foreign delegates were warmly welcomed and received much private hospitality, especially from Messrs Möller, Strandberg and Schmiegelow.

### THE AUTOBIOGRAPHY OF SIR FELIX SEMON, K.C.V.O., M.D., F.R.C.P.

The many friends of the late Sir Felix Semon will welcome the appearance of his autobiography, edited by his son, Dr Henry C. Semon, and Mr Thomas A. McIntyre. Much of what it contains is not only of general historical interest, but of special concern to those in this country engaged in the study of laryngology.

The reader is carried back to the War of 1870-71, and is given a vivid account of certain of its phases by one who was himself in action, and who rode with his squadron through the Brandenburger Thor on the return of the German troops to Berlin. The story of the fatal illness of the Emperor Frederick, although briefly told, is clear and concise. The struggle for the recognition of the specialty in London and the prominent part which Semon took in securing this, and his own early efforts in building up a practice, cannot fail to interest the younger generation. Short pen portraits of many persons and personalities in public life are sketched with a light and often humorous touch.

In the evening of life, saddened by the Great War, his outlook on the world becomes altered. "Except my own family, I have nothing left that interests me." We recommend to our readers the perusal of this volume.




# OPERATION CHAIR

The Chair is designed for operative work on the head and neck under an anæsthetic and for general use in nose and throat work. It is sufficiently rigid for operations on the brain, mastoid, and gas-serian ganglion.

The seat can be raised and lowered.

The back can be adjusted to any angle and with the arm supports in position it is impossible for the patient to move while under the anæsthetic.
