Seek advice from your local University Computer Centre if you are unsure as to whether there is a gopher client you can access.

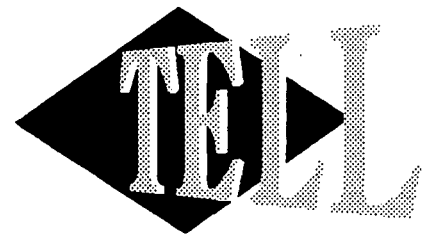
## The TELL Consortium: Preliminary Materials

During April, a parcel containing twelve preliminary versions of programs developed by the TELL consortium was delivered to Vice-Chancellors and Principals of higher education institutions funded by the UK Higher Education Funding Councils. These are beta-test versions which are still being rigorously evaluated within the consortium. However, the programs are at a stage of development where they may usefully be used by students.

Whilst we are anxious to obtain as much informal feedback as possible, we would recommend that the programs are used with care, and that users are made aware that the materials are unfinished.
