## Marine Turtles in the Comoro Archipelago J.G. Frazier

North-Holland Publishing Company, Amsterdam, Oxford and New York, 1985, 177 pp, DFL95·00 (available from Royal Netherlands Academy of Science, PO Box 19121, 1000 GC, Amsterdam, The Netherlands)

The results of the studies published here form part of a larger project to assess the status and distribution of sea turtles in the western Indian Ocean. This report is the first detailed account of marine turtles in the Comores and also describes the geography, climate, political status and people of the islands. The project was partly funded by the FFPS.

### Wings in the Sea: The Humpback Whale
