

DOCTORAL DISSERTATIONS ON RUSSIA, THE SOVIET UNION,
AND EASTERN EUROPE ACCEPTED BY AMERICAN,
CANADIAN, AND BRITISH UNIVERSITIES, 1969-1970

Despite the fact that the last decade produced more doctoral research on Russia and the Soviet Union than the combined output of the previous century, the areas in which very little had been done prior to 1960, such as art and architecture, anthropology and archaeology, communications, drama and theater, education, geography and geology, and so forth, have not opened up to any really noticeable extent. (A follow-up volume to my *Doctoral Research on Russia and the Soviet Union*, New York University Press, 1960, will explore this and other matters in more detail.) The bulk of the research in this year's listing, as in the past, is to be found in history, political science, literature, and language.

On the statistical side an additional thirty-four 1968 Russian and Soviet Union titles are listed in this issue, which can be added to the one hundred sixty-four listed in December 1968 and December 1969. A supplementary list of sixty-four 1969 titles can be added to the seventy-nine listed in the December 1969 issue of the *Slavic Review*.

Because degrees are also granted by most universities past the usual June commencement, with some awarded as late as December, complete coverage in current listings is not possible at this time. In addition, the delayed responses of a handful of graduate schools, the unavailability of a few university doctoral lists, the very late appearance of *American Doctoral Dissertations* by as much as a year and a half, and a publication deadline prevent the 1970 listing from being complete. Eighty of these 1970 Russian and Soviet Union titles are listed. Sixty-nine titles of dissertations on Eastern Europe for 1969-70 are listed.

Approximately sixty American and Canadian universities are represented in this combined list. The separate British list includes twenty-five dissertations, from the University of London (twelve), Cambridge University (seven), and Oxford University (six), two-thirds of which are concerned with Russia and the Soviet Union.

Twenty supplementary items referred to as "auxiliary theses" have been appended to several of the sections. These dissertations are not concerned primarily with Russia, the Soviet Union, and Eastern Europe, but they do contain enough relevant information of interest and value—in various chapters or sections—to warrant their inclusion.

It is appropriate to note in this section that the publishing of a dissertations-in-progress list, which appeared previously in *External Affairs* (U.S. Department of State) for a number of years and was then discontinued, will be resumed shortly by the Slavic Bibliographic and Documentation Center (1527 New Hampshire Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20036).
