The Summer 1972 issue of the journal *Social Research* contains the papers delivered at the October 1971 Conference on Weimar Germany, held at the New School for Social Research and cosponsored by the CGGP.

Commencing with Volume VII (1972), the Journal of Contemporary History will be published by Sage Publications, 275 South Beverly Drive, Beverly Hills, California 90212. This new arrangement supersedes the previously announced transfer of publication from Weidenfeld & Nicolson to Greenwood Periodicals. In order to catch up with delays in regular publication during the transfer of publication, Sage is publishing two double issues during 1972 (in July and October) instead of the usual four issues. Quarterly publication will resume with Volume VIII, commencing January 1973.
