Texts concerning these subjects, with translations and comments, will be considered; exclusively philological articles will not be accepted.

Contributors are requested to submit for illustration only clear prints of photographs or strong outline drawings. For oriental languages, transliteration into Roman script on the approved system should be employed, as laid down in the 'Notice to Contributors,' which will be sent on application.
