Charles A. Fawsitt.

CHARLES A. FAWSITT, who was a Chemical Manufacturer in Glasgow, was elected a Fellow of the Society in 1888. He collaborated with the late Professor Dittmar in an investigation of the specific gravities of solutions of methyl alcohol of various concentrations, the results of which were communicated to the Society in 1887 (*Trans.*, vol. xxxiii, pp. 509-34).

He died on 16th February 1928; his son, Dr Charles Edward Fawsitt, is Professor of Chemistry in the University of Sydney.
