THE EDITORSHIP OF THE BRITISH JOURNAL FOR THE HISTORY OF SCIENCE

Dr Robert Fox will relinquish the editorship of *The British Journal for the History of Science* in May 1977, after serving as editor since 1971. His successor is Dr Nicholas Fisher.

The British Society for the History of Science has appointed Dr Fox and Dr Fisher to act as joint editors for the current year, 1976-7, and the issues of *The British Journal for the History of Science* for 1977 (Volume X) will appear under their joint editorship. Beginning with Volume XI (1978), Dr Fisher will assume sole responsibility.

Dr Fox will continue to deal with articles and reviews already in hand, but new material for publication and books for review should be sent to Dr N. W. Fisher, Department of History and Philosophy of Science, King's College, Aberdeen AB9 2UB.
