

In Memoriam Ronald S. Wilson 1933 — 1986

Dr. Ronald S. Wilson, Director of the Louisville Twin Study, a Founding Fellow, past Vice President and current Chairman of the Membership Committee of the International Society for Twin Studies, suddently died from a heart attack on 16 November 1986.

Dr. Wilson had greatly contributed to ISTS since the very beginning and his outstanding scientific production in twin research, behavior genetics and developmental biology, was very well known worldwide.

An in Memoriam will appear in the proceedings of the Amsterdam congress, preceding the section on developmental studies.
