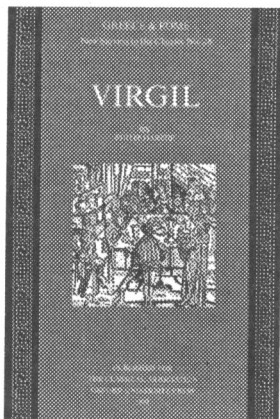


# NEW SURVEYS IN THE CLASSICS

The author revisits the subject of the first New Survey in the Classics, published in 1967, and explores the new literary approaches of the last thirty years. This New Survey is well over twice the length of the original. Individual chapters are devoted to Virgil's three major works, the *Eclogues*, *Georgics*, and *Aeneid*, and there is a final chapter on style, in which a passage of the *Aeneid* is closely analysed, using the techniques of practical criticism.
