

The author revisits the subject of the first New Survey in the Classics, published in 1967, and explores the new literary approaches of the last thirty years. Georgics, and Aeneid. and there is a final chapter on style, in which a passage of the Aeneid is closely analysed, using the techniques of practical criticism.
