THE GENERAL EDITOR OF A Concordance to Milton's English Prose, Laurence Sterne (Drexel U), is interested in finding editors for computer-assisted concordances to Volumes III and v of the Complete Works of John Milton, ed. Don M. Wolfe, et al. (New Haven, 1953—). Editors will be sought later for subsequent volumes. No experience with computers is necessary. The project requires much detail work, including marking of Yale texts for transcription; supervision of the keyboarding; proofreading and correcting; preparation of cross-referencing notes; and the writing of prefaces to each volume. The editorship is unsalaried, and part of the editor's responsibility is the raising of funds, exclusive of publishing costs, for his own volume through his own institution, foundations, or some other means.

The two-volume concordance to Volume I of the Yale *Prose Works*, edited by Laurence and Noel Sterne, will be in press by the spring of 1971 under the imprint of Southern Illinois University Press. When completed, the series will comprise about twelve volumes.
