The larger part of the analysis of the composer's works is taken up with opera, but the reader who turns to those chapters that deal with the chamber works, the songs, and the choral works will discover that Pizzetti's mind; naturally stimulated though it is by the stage, is also deeply moved to expression in other styles of composition.
