The mail ballot on the resolution to change the by-laws to create the category of sustaining member has been overwhelmingly approved, and the by-laws have been altered as proposed (see *Newsletter*, December 1977, p. 28-30).

A number of members indicated a desire to become sustaining members if the resolution passed but neglected to sign their names to the sheet they returned with dues payment. We regret we have no way of identifying these individuals.

Sustaining members may register without charge at the annual meeting in November.
