THE SEMON LECTURE, 1925.

On the afternoon of Thursday, 5th November, Dr Patrick Watson-Williams of Bristol, delivered the Semon Lecture of the University of London, entitled, "The Toll of Chronic Focal Nasal Sepsis on Body and Mind." The Lecturer was introduced by the Chairman, Sir William Milligan, to a large and appreciative audience assembled in the Hall of the Royal Society of Medicine. The address is published in the current number of the *Journal*.

The vote of thanks was proposed by Dr E. Graham Little, Member of Parliament for the University of London, and was seconded by Sir St Clair Thomson, President of the Royal Society of Medicine. The Lecturer was presented by the Chairman with the Semon Medal.

THE LATE DR HENRI CHÂTELLIER, PARIS.

Born at Lisieux in Normandy, in June 1855, Henri Châtellier studied medicine in Paris. Attracted by the busy life of the capital, he resolved to remain there and to specialise as an obstetrician; but after accepting an offer of work with Gouguenheim and later with Hutinel, he commenced the study of Diseases of the Throat and Ear.

In 1888, he wrote his Thesis on Adenoid Tumours of the Pharynx, and then proceeded to Vienna to study under Politzer, Chiari and Schnitzler, and in Prague under Zaufal. In 1890, Châtellier established a department of Otology and Laryngology at the Hôpital St Joseph. Amongst his chief contributions to the literature of the specialty were his papers on the Histology of the Nasal Mucous Membrane, on the Topographical Anatomy of the Middle Ear, and on the Bacteriology of Middle-ear Suppuration.

Châtellier had many interests outside the sphere of his profession. Music had a special attraction for him, and he was the means of introducing to the notice of the public many musicians, both composers and performers. During the active years of his life he was greatly interested in the development of sport.

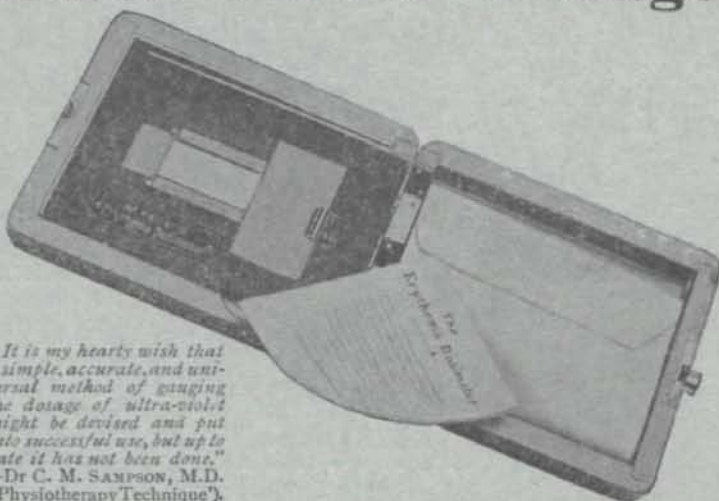

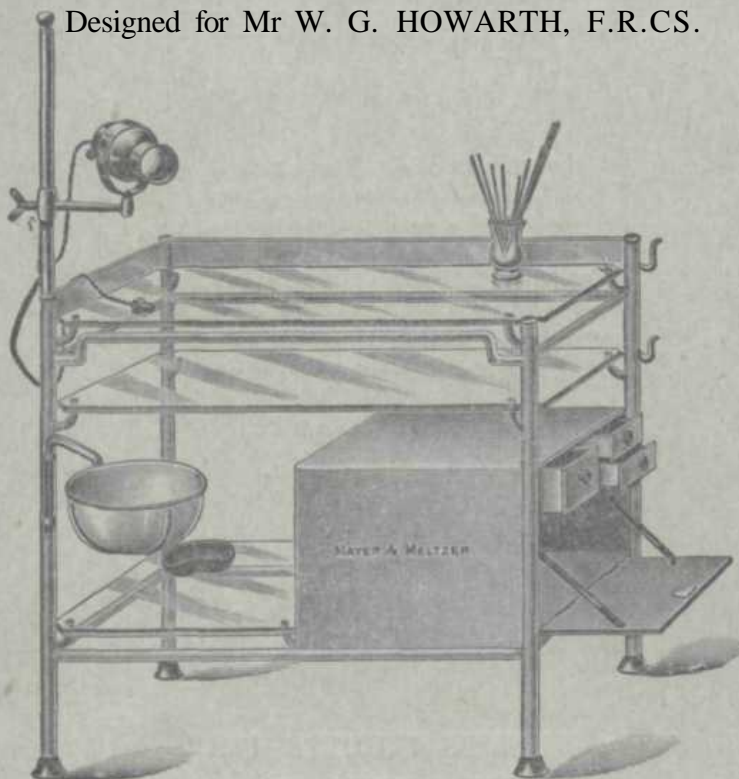
