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**Cover photograph:** The Northern Bald Ibis *Geronticus eremita* is an Endangered bird species of which only very few wild breeding colonies have survived along the Atlantic coast of south-west Morocco. In this issue, Andre Schenker *et al.* analysed ecological conditions at the 72 breeding sites that have been known since 1900 in Morocco. Two elements emerged as the most important prerequisites: a low level of disturbance at the breeding site, and suitable feeding areas at a distance of 5–15 km.
