Membership Examination --- Mon. 22-Wed. 24 (Clinicals and Orals) May 1978

The closing date for receipt of entries is WEDNES-DAY 1 MARCH 1978.

The written papers will be held in London, Birmingham, Glasgow and Dublin. The clinical and oral examinations will be held in London, Birmingham and Glasgow.

The fees for each entry are £25 for the Preliminary Test and \pounds_{35} for the Membership Examination. PLEASE NOTE that the reduced re-sit fees have now been discontinued.

Prospective candidates are reminded that late entries WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED and that the College no longer gives exemption from any part of the examinations. Candidates who were previously granted exemption from the Preliminary Test (i.e. before June 1973) are reminded that they must pass the Membership Examination within five years from the date of granting in order to retain their exemption.

In cases where candidates have undertaken parttime or overseas experience in psychiatry, or are required to submit the name and address of their Clinical Tutor or Consultant Chief, the entry forms should be submitted at least three weeks in advance so that the application may be finalized before the closing date is reached.

Regulations and application forms are obtainable from the Examinations Secretary at 17 Belgrave Square, London SW1X 8PG, together with copies of past essay question papers at 50p per set for 1971-75 inclusive and 20p per set for 1976-77 inclusive.
