Issues of the *Bulletin* will be sent to :—

- (1) Member governments and member organizations of IUCN ;
- (2) Libraries, institutes, universities, and other organizations on an exchange basis ;
- (3) *Friends of IUCN* who signify that they will conform to a new minimum annual contribution, to be established by the Executive Board in May, 1962. A small portion of this contribution will be used to send *Friends* the IUCN *Bulletin*. The balance is urgently needed to support IUCN's expanded general programme.
