New Editions and Reprints

BIBLIOTHECA CORVINIANA: DIE BIBLIOTHEK DES KÖNIGS MATTHIAS CORVINUS VON UNGARN. This is the second edition (336 pages) of the volume edited by Dr. Csaba Csapodi and Dr. Klara Csapodi-Gardonyi and published in Budapest by Magyar Helikon in Hungarian, German, and English. The volume was first published in 1969. This 1978 edition includes a scholarly introduction on the library of King Matthias Corvinus of Hungary (d. 1490) and its history; a critical description of 194 volumes, most of them illuminated manuscripts which were once a part of that library and are now scattered over Europe and the United States; and 114 color reproductions (seven of them new plates), with full descriptions, of the illuminated title pages and of a few bindings that decorate many of these volumes. The bibliography and footnotes have been brought up to date. [P.O.K.]
