On p. 575, the date for the beginning of Blackstone’s lectures at All Souls should be 1753 rather than 1758.

On p. 575, n. 34, Blackstone’s *Analysis* (1756) was a syllabus for those lectures, which had already begun.

On p. 575, to clarify, Bentham was still in residence at Queen’s College, though he had also enrolled at Lincoln’s Inn.

On p. 576, n. 36, Blackstone’s postscript for the posthumously published 9<sup>th</sup> edition of his *Commentaries* (1783) was reprinted from the 8<sup>th</sup> edition (1778), which appeared before his death in 1780.
