## CALL FOR PAPERS

The 1984 Annual meeting of the American Society of Church History will be held in Chicago, Illinois, 27-30 December 1984. The program committee welcomes proposals for entire sessions, individual papers, or panels. Papers may be on any aspect of the history of Christianity. Among other topics we are also interested in forming sessions dealing with the Orthodox church. Each proposal must include an abstract that summarizes its thesis, method, and significance, together with a curriculum vitae for each participant.

## BREWER PRIZE CONTEST

The American Society of Church History is pleased to announce a new competition in 1983 for a booklength manuscript in church history. The award will consist of a subsidy of $\$ 2,000.00$ to assist the author in the publication of the manuscript. The winning manuscript shall be published in a manner acceptable to the Society, and have printed on its title page, "The Frank S. and Elizabeth D. Brewer Prize Essay of the American Society of Church History." If competing essays are otherwise of equal quality, preference will be given to those topics relating to the history of Congregationalism.

Complete manuscripts in final form, fully annotated, must be received by William $B$. Miller, Secretary, American Society of Church History, 305 East Country Club Lane, Wallingford, PA 19086, by 15 December 1983, with return postage included.

The award will be announced at the spring meeting of the Society in 1984.

The 1982 winner of the Brewer Prize was "The Metaphysical Confederacy: James Henley Thornwell and the Synthesis of Southern Values,' by James O. Farmer, Jr.
