***Doctoral Dissertations  
on Russia, the Soviet Union, and Eastern  
Europe Accepted by American,  
Canadian, and British Universities, 1971–1972***

The continuous growth in doctoral research on Russia and the Soviet Union in American and Canadian universities shows no abatement. This year's list of two hundred fifty-eight titles, again larger than any previous year's, is made up of four for 1969, twenty-four for 1970, one hundred thirty-one additional for 1971, ninety-nine for 1972, and one recently brought to light for 1950. Because degrees are also granted by most universities past the usual June commencement, with some awarded as late as December, complete coverage in current listings is not possible at this time. In addition, the delayed responses of a handful of graduate schools, the practice of a few universities of refusing to compile doctoral lists, the very late appearance of *American Doctoral Dissertations* by as much as two years, and a publication deadline prevent the 1972 listing from being complete. Of the sixty-seven (sixty-two American and five Canadian) universities represented in the present list, Columbia University and Indiana University are the outstanding producers by far, with the University of Wisconsin, Yale University, the University of Chicago, and Georgetown University also producing a fairly significant number. The listing for Eastern Europe, with its one hundred fifty titles by sixty-seven American and three Canadian universities, is also larger than in any previous year. The separate British list is slightly smaller this year, with twenty-four dissertations. No 1972 titles are included, because none of the lists arrived before the deadline. This is particularly regrettable for the University of London—usually the major producer. Despite this, the list is as large as it is because the compiler caught up belatedly with some older lists for smaller British universities. Eleven British universities are represented, and the 1972 items will be included in next year's listing. Twenty supplementary items, "auxiliary theses," have been appended to several sections. These dissertations are not concerned primarily with Russia, the Soviet Union, or Eastern Europe, but they do contain enough relevant information to warrant their inclusion. In the listing as a whole, the bulk of the research is again to be found in history, political science, economics, literature, and language.
