Design and applied arts index is the first fully comprehensive international index to current design and design-related journals. It is published twice a year, covering January-June and July-December, and is cumulated every three years. Since publication of the first issue in February 1988 we have made a number of important changes to **design and applied arts index**. As from Volume 2 (1988) we have significantly increased the type and range of material indexed. This includes:

- * A substantial increase in the number of journals indexed.
- * The retrospective indexing of certain journals, including **Craft Arts** (Australia) from 1984, **Design World** (Australia) from 1983, **DesignWeek** (UK) from 1986, **The Journal of Decorative and Propaganda Arts** (USA) from 1986, and **Blueprint** (UK) from 1983. Other titles will follow.
- * The inclusion of books, exhibition catalogues, theses and dissertations, and film and video material.

Daai is set up as a database and can, if required, provide subscribers with key word search facilities. Although not yet available on-line, we can respond to users' enquiries either by post, telephone or fax.
