#### *French Summaries of Important Articles.*

In response to numerous requests the Editor has decided to revive the practice of giving a summary in a second language of some of the more important articles appearing in the Journal. Previous experience has shown that unless the authors of articles themselves supply the summaries it is extremely difficult, if not altogether impossible, to provide a satisfactory service of this kind. Contributors are therefore requested to collaborate by sending a brief *résumé* of their papers with their manuscripts. As a general rule the summaries will appear in French, as the requests for their provision have mainly come from French-speaking readers, and Professor Labouret has kindly undertaken to make himself responsible for the translation.
