

New Edition Charles W. Hayford

The World Bibliographical Series from ABC-CLIO has long been recognised as setting an unmatched standard of excellence. Hayford has taught at Harvard University, Oberlin College, the Chinese University of Hong Kong, the University of Illinois at Chicago, Northwestern University and Stanford University. Dr Hayford's scholarly publications are principally concerned with modern Chinese social and cultural history as well as Sino-US relations. From 1990-94 he was Book Review Editor (China/Inner Asia) for the Journal of Asian Studies.
