



FREDERICK S. DUNN

It is with deep sorrow that we announce the death on March 17 of Professor Frederick S. Dunn who, until his retirement in 1961, was Director of the Center of International Studies at Princeton University and Chairman of the Editorial Board of *World Politics*.

Professor Dunn was not only the founder of *World Politics*, a journal which is now in its fourteenth year and has contributed to the communication of academic knowledge resulting from researches on problems of international and related affairs. He also exerted a leading influence on the rigorous study of international relations and foreign policy. Indeed, the development of this branch of academic research in the United States owes much to the stimulus and guidance that Professor Dunn gave to it, beginning in the early 1930's, at a time when study in this field was at a markedly low level. It is for this reason that we have asked Professor William T. R. Fox of Columbia University to write an article on Professor Dunn's work. This paper will appear in our October 1962 issue.
