STATEMENT OF POLICY OF THE CANADIAN MATHEMATICAL BULLETIN

The Canadian Mathematical Bulletin is not an international journal. It is the successor to the Congress newsletter, and is the official house organ of the Canadian Mathematical Congress; it includes items which are generally of interest only to Canadians. The services of the Bulletin are open to all Canadians. This courtesy is extended to former residents (i.e., staff and students who were in the past at a Canadian institution, but are now residing outside Canada). In exceptional cases, manuscripts from others are considered e.g. if the manuscript contains the results of a lecture delivered by the author at a Canadian University during a visit; or if the contents of the paper are in some sense a sequel to papers published in the Bulletin or the Canadian Journal of Mathematics.
