The History of Education Society (USA) is pleased to announce that its 1983 annual meeting, co-sponsored with the Pacific Coast History of Education Society (PCHES), will be held in conjunction with the annual meeting of the Canadian History of Education Association (CHEA) at the University of British Columbia from October 14 to 16, 1983.

Proposals for individual papers, sessions and panels concerning the history of education, broadly conceived, are cordially invited. Proposals for sessions and panels are especially encouraged.

Papers treating the following themes will be particularly welcome:

1. Educational interchange and influences: United States, Canada, Europe.
2. Familial, voluntary and private education.
3. War, military preparation and education (not confined to the modern period).
4. Rural education.
5. Religion, education, and culture.
6. Education and the uses (and misuses) of nature.

Proposals of about one page in length should be addressed to any of HES program committee members below, and should reach the committee no later than March, 15. Decisions will be made on those to be included in the program by March, 1983.
